For our youngest learners – from Nursery to Year 2 – the Pre–Prep is where their journey of learning begins. Our Nursery warmly welcomes children from the tender age of two, setting the stage for their educational voyage through our Pre–Prep and beyond. At Sevenoaks Prep, we see each child as a unique individual, nurturing their strengths and recognising their achievements as they grow and develop.

Here, we celebrate childhood in all its glory - creating a learning environment that is as exciting as it is adventurous, where every day is filled with opportunities to explore, discover and create magical moments. Our family ethos runs deep, ensuring that every child feels valued, supported and nurtured.





PREP

The Prep School is home to Years 3 to 8. We provide a rich and varied curriculum which is stimulating, ambitious and flexible enough to suit the ability of each child and to bring out the best in all our pupils. Alongside more traditional subjects like maths and English, we offer languages, digital learning, art and design, drama, outdoor learning, critical thinking, music and sport – all of which are integral to the life of the School. All classes participate in a regular programme of visits, workshops and field trips to enrich their learning and have fun. From theatre visits and residentials to ski trips, each activity is an opportunity to expand our pupils' horizons and make memories that will stay with them for life.



ACADEMIC SUCCESS

We feel children are at their best within a happy, diverse community of learners. We make sure they are stretched at the appropriate time, producing their best without unnecessary pressure. All pupils benefit from subject specialist teachers, with this increasing as they progress through the school. Our teachers ensure that every pupil is motivated, challenged and prepared for examinations and scholarships to both independent and local grammar schools. Our pupils achieve excellent academic results and are successful in gaining entry into schools of their choice for both Year 7 and Year 9. Many of our pupils earn academic, music, drama and sport scholarships to leading independent schools including Sevenoaks, Tonbridge, Caterham and Hurstpierpoint College. Each year, our pupils gain places at grammar schools such as Judd, Tonbridge Grammar, Cranbrook and Weald of Kent.

SPORT FOR ALL

At Sevenoaks Prep sport is for all. Our comprehensive physical education curriculum begins in the Pre-Prep where pupils are introduced to a variety of sports. The main sports for our Prep pupils are athletics, cricket, cross-country, football, hockey, netball and rugby – with every child representing the school in regular fixtures against local schools and our teams frequently excelling in local and national tournaments. In our cricket programme, boys and girls play together on teams selected by ability, not gender, from U8 to our 1st XI. Our games programme runs alongside regular PE lessons where pupils learn about the importance of health and wellbeing and develop their fitness through a range of activities.

Our sports programme does not stop here; every child has the opportunity to try their hand at a number of other sports through our extensive range of clubs including fencing, judo, gymnastics, indoor

rowing and tennis.

THE CREATIVE ARTS

Music is a significant part of pupils' lives at Sevenoaks Prep. Every child enjoys at least one timetabled music lesson per week lasting an hour. It is an inspiring, creative curriculum which allows pupils to explore a wide variety of genres and composers, fostering a sense of creativity, collaboration and excitement about performance.

Every pupil from Year 3 has a weekly drama lesson with a curriculum that encourages an understanding of performance technique and communication. LAMDA sessions are available for pupils from Year 1 and pupils take part in a range of external competitions. Children perform on stage in their nativity and end of year shows throughout the Pre-Prep. In the Prep school, we have four school drama productions each year and all pupils are encouraged to take part, either on stage or behind the scenes.

From Reception to Year 8, all children have art lessons in our inspiring, purpose-built art studio. The curriculum covers a diverse range of materials, techniques, styles and cultural influences to help each child find their creative outlet. Our pupils have the opportunity to explore their imagination and gain creative confidence in digital art, sculpture, prop making, photography, textiles, painting and more.


A CULTURE OF KINDNESS


